Day 1

Arrival in Zurich. We will depart by coach for Basel, where we will enjoy a short orientation visit and free time in the city centre. We will then continue our journey to Strasbourg. Upon arrival, we will check in to our hotel and have time to settle in before enjoying our first evening in the heart of the Christmas Capital of Europe.

Day 2

After breakfast, we will begin our panoramic tour of Strasbourg. We will discover the picturesque district of La Petite France, famous for its canals, half-timbered houses and traditional Alsatian restaurants. We will visit the magnificent Notre-Dame Cathedral, admire its

famous Astronomical Clock, and see the historic Ponts Couverts, the Vauban Dam, and Place de la République.

We will also enjoy a walk through the beautiful Parc de l'Orangerie before taking a relaxing boat cruise through Strasbourg's canals, offering a unique view of the city. The remainder of the day will be free for students to explore Strasbourg's world-famous centre.

Day 3

Following breakfast, we will travel through the enchanting villages of Alsace. Our first stop will be Eguisheim, one of France's most beautiful villages, known for its circular streets, colourful houses and vineyards.

We will then continue to Colmar, often described as the jewel of Alsace. During our visit, we will explore its charming historic centre, admire the Saint Martin Church, wander through its picturesque squares and enjoy free time in the famous Little Venice district.

Later, we will visit Riquewihr, a beautifully preserved medieval village surrounded by vineyards. Students will have the opportunity to stroll through its historic streets and experience the magical Christmas atmosphere before returning to Strasbourg in the evening.

Day 4

After breakfast, we will depart for Europa-Park, one of Europe's largest and most popular theme parks. The Park features over one hundred attractions, thrilling roller coasters, themed areas and spectacular Christmas decorations.

Students will have the entire day to enjoy the festive atmosphere and attractions. We will return to Strasbourg in the late afternoon.

Day 5

After breakfast and check-out, we will depart for Zurich Airport for our return flight to Larnaca.
